<u>Learning About Our Hosts!</u> – Our guest speaker this week was Dr. Kristen Miller, who just completed her first year serving as the president of Southern Maine Community College. Chris Speh read off a lot of accomplishments in introducing her but what impressed me most about her is that she has completed the Boston Marathon, and plans to run it again in April with her twin brother. Dr. Miller also began her presentation by singing the praises of South Portland Middle School where her daughter attends school. She made some very positive observations about the college, such as the fact that SMCC is an "incredible family" and that free tuition has allowed many students to attend two

years at a community college before transitioning to a 4-year institution, which has proven to be very successful for students. However despite the many things that SMCC has going for it, the college also has some significant challenges. In looking around at our weekly meetings, we can see that the college has deferred maintenance issues – she said they amount to over \$100 million. And although there are plenty of jobs in fields like automotive and HVAC, they don't have enough facilities & equipment to keep up with the demand. This is just a fraction of the very informative presentation that she gave – it was interesting for us to learn more about our hosts at SMCC.
