- You already have an account on the club and district site. You'll get your login information there. Go to the web page, click login, and then on the "Magic Link". Fill in your email and the system will send you a login. After you are in you can go to your profile and change the password. The district and club login information is the same.
- Get the Clubrunner app for your phone. Instructions are on the home page.
- Most information of interest is on the "Members Menu" on the right side of the home page menu bar. Spend some time exploring the club website. From the website you can
 - Get the weekly bulletin
 - Use the photo directory to see who that person was that you were talking with....
 - See who the speaker will be
 - See what events are planned
 - Check your attendance record and credited make ups.
 - Find the bylaws
 - Get information about projects
 - Find out what committees are defined and who's on them
 - Get member email and phone numbers (please keep them private!)
 - Find out who is on the board and contact them
- You can get to the club and district social media pages from the websites. See "Our Club" on the menu bar. Both are open for posting.

Profile

- Your online profile is important in several respects. Please fill it out as completely as possible, including birthdays and anniversaries. The system will hide the year from most members.
- Please add a photo if one isn't there.

Meals

- Members arrive to the dining hall about 5:15. Pay the cashier if you want to eat.

Event sign ups

- These are generally done via the club website. Sometimes you will see a paper signup passed around.
- If you signed up but can't make it, please find a replacement if possible. If that's not possible, please let the organizer know.

Duty Roster

- When you get the bulletin you will see assignments at the end.

- Rotary Fellowships – are groups of Rotarians that get together to pursue a common interest such as golf, skiing, bicycling, chess, computers, etc.

Proposing

- You can, and are encouraged to propose projects. Let the appropriate director know (Community, International, etc), or if not available any board member.
- You can and are encouraged to propose fundraisers. Best contact is a member of the fundraising committee or our VP. Or any board member.
- You can, and are strongly encouraged to, propose new members. See a Membership Committee member, or the Membership director.

- Feel free to ask any board member, or any other member if you have a question.
