The public part of the website also contains links to other sites and information, including at the “About our Club” link, Dan Davidson’s informative brochure and Jim Russell’s weekly club bulletin.

Access the private “Members Only” part of the website by clicking on the Login link on the bar that appears near the top of the public web page. You will need your user name (which is your email address initially, though you can change it to something shorter if you’d like) and your password. If you don’t know your password, click on “I forgot my password” and your password will be emailed to you.

At the private part of the site you can:

- **See pictures and info about all active club members.**
- **Edit your info or change your picture.**
- **Change your password.**
- **View and print important club documents, such as our bylaws and membership proposal forms.**
