Our special thanks go to Janis Beach, all of the SBC Pioneers and the teachers and staff at all the elementary schools who helped prepare the materials for the books.

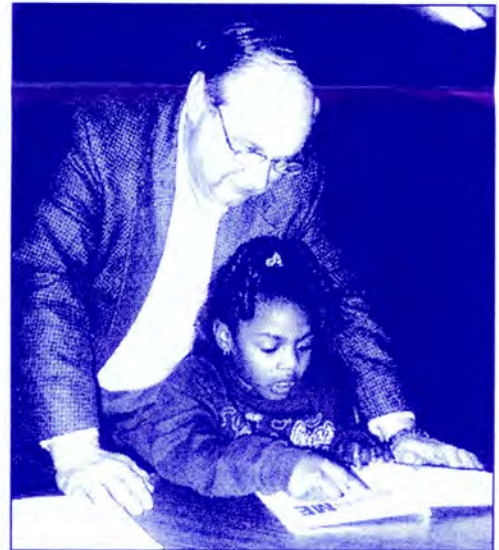
We were rewarded with warm welcomes, hugs and applause.
