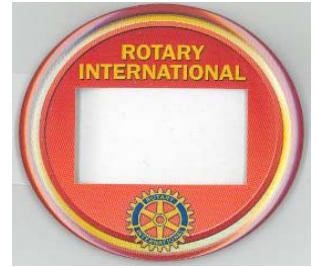

Program Review of April 13, 2011

Group Study Exchange from Germany by Rotarian John Neely

Our Rotary speaker today, April 13, 2011, was Rotary International Team Leader Manfred Grabsch, Representing Distrikt 1930, of Germany. Mr. Grabsch was introduced by Sharon McCabe, who, in turn, introduced his Group Study Exchange Group: Peter Eiswirt, Barbara Klump, Christian Suhr, and Theresia Weiber.

Manfred has been a Rotarian since 1975, and participated in the Rotary Group Study Exchange in Brazil, last year. After introducing the Team Members, each spoke briefly about their occupations and interests. Barbara is a biologist and lifeguard; Peter is a marketing manager and a tennis instructor, for youth; Christian is a product manager and a member of the fire auxillary; Theresia is an environmental, health, and safety engineer and loves gardening.



In a question and answer-format, the Group Study Exchange Team asked the audience questions about our knowledge of Germany....and, compassionately, answered those questions for our audience ☺

- Who invented the automobile ? Carl Benz in 1885
- Why are there speedometers up to 200 mph in the Porsche? There are no speed limits.
- What is the currency standard for Europe? The Euro
- How much is a gallon of gasoline in Germany? \$ 8.50
- What does Germany export ? automobiles, beer, machinery, tools, clocks, & computers

District 1930 is in the Lake Constance-region of Germany, and borders Austria and France. We were treated to a presentation about the beauty and resourcefulness of Germany as well as District 1930. The landscape is beautifully decorated with fine homes, mansions, and castles.....and presently, is enjoying a robust economic climate. Any listener could feel the pride of the speakers, when they would mention the trademark: "made in Germany."
