IT'S ANOTHER AMERICAN FLAG DAY!

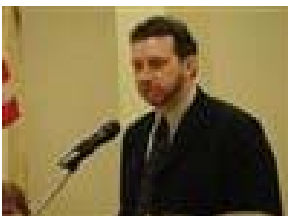

Program Review of May 18, 2011

Paul Latiolais Director of Lamar University's Innovation and Commercialization Center



Paul Latiolais is the Director of the Innovation and Commercialization Center at Lamar University. This program serves as a platform where ideas for businesses, entrepreneurship, and economic development can become reality through strategic models.

The Center is a collaborative agreement between the Colleges of Business and Engineering. It helps identify the best ideas that are brought to them and select paths where the product and/or service of interest can become a common reality and brought to the market as a legitimate, consumable product. This includes analysis of the viability, marketing, and financing of the particular concepts.

To provide an example of some of the Center's work, Mr. Latiolais discussed an idea from a local citizen about how emergency vehicles could communicate with drivers through a specific device in a person's car. The Center helped determine whether the idea was legitimate, if such an idea was needed, whether it would be cost efficient, and whether it could actually be produced. Currently, patents for this product are being sought and the long-term viability of if it is being analyzed.
