



# PROGRAM REVIEW August 15, 2012 "A Congressional Update"



Congressman Ted Poe Second District of Texas by Rotarian Chris Ayers

Ted Poe was born and raised in Texas and has served as our Congressman since 2004. He is a firm believer in Conservative principles, limited and smaller governments and of maintaining individual liberties.

Most recently he was responsible for getting a law passed that would allow Beaumont to have access to funds generated from natural resource exploration on the municipal airport grounds. This will give the city \$50,000,000 to use at their discretion – mostly street improvements. We are all grateful for that!

Regarding the economy, Ted Poe works for a balanced budget. Every day the U.S. receives \$5 Billion into the Treasury. However, every day the U.S. spends \$9 billion which leads to \$4 billion in daily deficits. He stated that there is several ways to remedy the deficit. One is to develop a sunset provision on government programs. This will limit the time, resources, and commitments that the government utilizes to maintain programs and overtime would save money. Also, the government could be more watchful regarding fraud and abuse of federal systems. According to the FBI, each year Medicare wastes \$67 billion in fraud and abuse. Ultimately, these ideas are good but won't provide enough of a savings to diminish the deficit to a maintainable number. Reducing spending would be the only way.

Finally, Ted Poe leads the Victim's Rights Caucus. The purpose of this caucus is to educate the general public of the dangers of human trafficking and the crime

associated with it. The driving forces behind it are the Mexican drug cartels. Congressman Poe stated that Houston, TX is becoming a hub for this type of crime.
