

The list of donors to the Beaumont Rotary Centennial Playground project continues to grow each and every day.





"Texas Vietnam Veterans"

Mayor Becky Ames introduced Robert Floyd to speak about Texas' efforts to honor Vietnam Veterans.

Mr. Floyd and a number of other people, including Mayor Ames, are leading a charge to create a Vietnam Veterans Monument in Austin, TX, to join memorials for veterans of other wars at the state Capitol. Mr. Floyd began by showing a short video that provided an introduction to the monument and the efforts to establish it. The video mentioned that 3,415 Texans died in the Vietnam War.

The monument's website will feature numerous interactive components telling the stories of many of the servicemen who lost their lives during the war. The monument was designed to reflect the servicemen from Texas. It is also designed to represent Texas' ethnic diversity. The monument will be on the northeast side of the Capitol grounds. Mr. Floyd mentioned that many Vietnam veterans returned alone, rather than in armed forces units, and were generally not welcomed as heroes.

The monument began in 2003 as the brainchild of many lobbyists and others who spend a lot of time at the state Capitol. The state legislature unanimously passed a resolution in 2005 to authorize the building of the monument. Every effort has been made to make the monument's details as historically accurate as possible. The monument will acknowledge all branches of the military, the other service members and nurses, and will honor the Vietnamese people. Former First Lady, Lady Bird Johnson, was a longtime champion of this effort.

The monument's Board includes a Marine sniper, two Bronze Star and Purple Heart recipients, a Navy representative, and an Air Force representative who flew several hundred missions over Vietnam as a supply sergeant. Mr. Floyd describes the monument and this effort as a labor of love. He complimented Beaumont on its efforts to raise funds for the monument, and mentioned a fundraiser event scheduled for September 21-22.
