



President Mason introduced Past President Robert Robertson to speak about the history of the Rotary Club of Beaumont. Mr. Robertson mentioned that Charlie Weinbaum, despite his comments to the contrary, was NOT actually at the first meeting of the Rotary Club of Beaumont. Although Rotary was founded in Chicago with self interest for the growth of its founders' businesses, it very quickly became more greatly focused on public service and contributing to the greater good. Mr. Robertson emphasized the importance of Rotary as a source of public service and civic leadership through service activities and even weekly meetings.

The Beaumont Rotary Club was founded on February 26, 1913. Mr. Robertson listed a number of the founding members, discussing how they came to Beaumont and a little bit about what they did. Ed Emerson served as the first president of the Club. Mr. Robertson illustrated through quotes how much the Club's founding members were focused in developing the community and the future of Beaumont. Mr. Robertson also described some of the regional and community growth at the time of the Club's founding, specifically pointing out the expansion if the ship channel and it being a source of pride and development for Beaumont. Rotary members were important community leaders in the various civic and business organizations that were leading economic development at that time.

Early Beaumont Rotarians joined in support of Mayor B. A. Steinhagen denouncing Ku Klux Klan violence in Beaumont. The Club reached 350 members in 1973, diversified membership in 1972 with the first African American members, and again in 1987 with the first female club member, Margaret Cherb.

Ken Ruddy organized the Beaumont Rotary Foundation to fund local service projects. Mr. Robertson spent a few minutes talking about John Gray, former Lamar University President and President of the Rotary Club. John Gray became one of the most important community leaders who epitomized Rotary's motto of Service Above Self even beyond his work at Lamar. Mr. Robertson made it clear that John Gray's work was never done for any personal agenda...he truly wanted to improve all facets of community life in Beaumont.

As one Rotarian said, "Robert Robertson's presentation...was completely fascinating! I found myself wanting to hear MORE!"
