The Texas Justice System is the state agency for prisons, part Furthermore, they services 152,411 prisoners while local jails house over 1 millions inmates. 76% of inmates never return to prisons which is valuable to the state and have a GED or high school diploma with opportunities to earn college degrees. Inmates can also learn trades such as painting, asbestos removal, engine repair, complete largest pork production center in the state is controlled by a prison and other prisons produce cattle, chickens, and a variety of crops. Finally 'God Pod's'have bee teach. While you can get educated, learn a trade, produce food and find God in jail, the best way is probably to learn **outside** of a wall rather than inside.
