Simultaneously, it is time to recruit Team Member applicants. Those applications are due September 30. Interviews of applicants will be held on October 20. Training will start in November.

Consider someone you know and share with them how they can benefit from this opportunity. Team members stay in Rotarians' homes, share information about our part of the world while experiencing local hospitality, and learning more about the culture and economy of the host country.
