



#### **Baylor University**

The guest speaker for Rotary on May 8 was Ken Starr, Baylor University's 14th President. Judge Starr was eloquently and movingly introduced by Paula Bothe.

Judge Starr served as the Professor of Law at Pepperdine University School of Law. He was a Law Clerk from 1983 to 1989 for Chief Justice Warren E. Burger, earned his BA at George Washington University in 1968, an M.A. from Brown in 1969, and a J.D. from Duke University of Law in 1973.

Judge Starr is best known for his controversial investigation of figures during the Clinton administration. Starr was nominated for a judgeship on United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit by President Ronald Reagan and served from 1983 to 1989. He was the United States Solicitor General from 1989 to 1993 under President George H. W. Bush.

Ken Starr wished our Rotary Club a very happy 100 Year Centennial, and said that Rotary's slogan "Service Above Self" is a wonderful message to the world.

President Starr believes, along with many others, that the "on-campus, residential college experience accelerates the individual transformation for growth in college students."

President Starr reported that every year, the American Council of College Alumni and Trustees analyzes the "curriculum-rigorousness of 1,000 universities. Of that 1,000 universities, only 16 received the mark of "A." Lamar University, as well as Baylor University, BOTH received an "A."

President Starr stated that 'pass percentage' for the Naturalization Test to become a citizen of the United States is an astonishing 97%! Ken professed the age-old belief that "religion, morality, and knowledge are necessary to good government."
