

# "Real Experiences in the Space Program"



Al Sacco, Jr.

Dean of the College of Engineering

Texas Tech University

Payload Specialist on the Space Shuttle Columbia

There is perhaps nothing more more intriguing to humans than the wonders of space, the "great unknown." For years, we sat mesmerized in front of television to see lift-offs and landing. We were captivated by the stories of those who were brave enough to be sent into the vastness of space, and waited anxiously for the stories of their discoveries upon return. The small number of individuals selected for this challenge make it a truly rare and special opportunity to meet and hear firsthand of the experience that the great majority will never have.

We are privileged to welcome Al Sacco, Jr., as our speaker on Wednesday, November 14. He flew as the payload specialist on the Space Shuttle Columbia on shuttle mission STS-73 in 1995. The 16-day mission aboard Columbia focused on materials science, biotechnology, combustion science and fluid mechanics contained within the pressurized Spacelab module.

Al Sacco, Jr. is currently dean of the Edward E. Whitacre Jr. College of Engineering at Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas. Before accepting this assignment at Texas Tech, he was the George A. Snell Distinguished Professor of Engineering and the director



# Captain George "Joe" Paitl Commanding Officer, USCG Marine Safety Office

Captain Joe Paitl (Captain Joe) presented a powerful speech about veterans and active duty personnel to the club and our responsibility to support them for they are all distinguished in that they preserve our way of life and they are the greatest and bravest of men and women in our country. One out of nine members of the military is from Texas.

Captain Joe gave us two stories of bravery in the Coast Guard. Stories are to be differentiated from story tales beginning with "once upon a time". The two stories start with World War II Coast Guardsmen.

Douglas Monroe joined the Coast Guard on September 11, 1939. On Sept 27, 1942, Signalman 1<sup>st</sup>Class Douglas Albert Munro "provided a shield and covering fire, and helped evacuate 500 besieged Marines from a beach at Point Cruz, Guadalcanal". (Wikipedia) Signalman Munro headed 10 ships that day whose job it was to deliver marines to Point Cruz. After delivering the marines, it became apparent that they could not hold their position so the ships returned to rescue them. The final two marines who provided fire for the escaping marines were left on the island until Munro returned to pick them up. During the rescue, Signalman Munro was killed. His dying words were "Did they get off?"

Earl Fox entered World War II in the Navy and he commanded PT crews and a submarine in the South Pacific. He eventually received a Silver Star for his bravery in battle during WWII. He retired from the Navy at 55 as a Navy doctor. In 1974 he joined the Coast Guard after he had been granted an age waiver. He became a flight surgeon in the Coast Guard (and a pilot) over the Atlantic and Gulf Coast. He was a prime investigator in the crashes of several amphibious helicopters and his recommendations for changes in training are still utilized today. He retired again at the age of 71 and sadly died in September of 2012. He received the Legion of Merit Award and was honored by President Bill Clinton at Arlington Cemetery on Veterans Day.

Captain Joe urged us all to remember veterans and active duty members not just on Veterans Day, but every day. He received a well deserved standing ovation from Rotarians.
