"A Salute to Veterans"



Captain George "Joe" Paitl

Commanding Officer, USCG Marine Safety Office

In honor of all veterans, the Rotary Club of Beaumont will welcome Captain Joe Paitl as the speaker on Wednesday. Captain Joe plans to share stories and recognize veterans of military service. He has some special stories to share as we recognize all who have helped to keep our nation free and strong.

Captain Paitl assumed command of Marine Safety Port Arthur in July 2011. He comes to Port Arthur from his previous assignment as Deputy Commander, Sector Sault Sainte Marie, MI, during which he oversaw operations and administration of Coast Guard units in Michigan, Wisconsin, and Minnesota. He held this position from July 2008 to July 2011, while in 2010 temporarily deploying to Mobile, AL to serve as Deputy Incident Commander in response to the *Deepwater Horizon* drilling rig explosion and oil spill.

He began his military career in 1980 with the U.S. Air Force, working and flying on B-52 Bomber aircraft for ten years before transferring to the U.S. Coast Guard. He attended Coast Guard Officer Candidate School in Yorktown, VA, graduating in 1990.

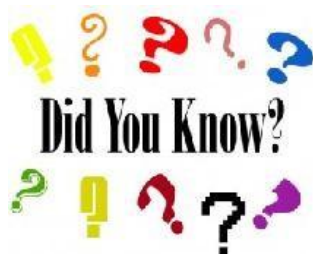

"My Journey and Adventures as a Rotary Ambassadorial Scholar"

Our speaker for Rotary today was Rebekah Maxwell, Rotary Ambassadorial Scholar for 2011-12. Ms. Maxwell was introduced by Rotarian Teresa Simpson. Ms. Maxwell enthusiastically presented "My Journey and Adventures as a Rotary Ambassadorial Scholar" with pictures and stories.

While Rebekah was extremely busy earning her Masters Degree in International Marketing at the University of Strathclyde in Glasgow, Scotland, she also had the opportunity to visit and fellowship with European Rotarians.

The Rotary Club of Glasgow was celebrating their Centennial during her time in Scotland. Rebekah stated that the Glasgow membership is male at this time, although there are 'hints' that this may change. European Rotarians seem to very involved with fundraising, although with less of a "hands-on" approach than we have in the USA. Participating in one of many fundraisers with fellow Ambassadorial Scholars, Rebekah climbed the three tallest peaks in the United Kingdom ... all within 28 hours! In addition, Ms. Maxwell took the opportunity to visit Italy (Venice), Amsterdam, Paris, London, Barcelona, and Wales. And, YES, she did attend the Olympics, a question she is frequently asked!

Rebekah credits her ability to attain her Masters degree to the earlier guidance she received at Lamar University. Graduation will take place in Scotland, in November 2012. Ms. Maxwell expressed her sincere appreciation to the Rotary Club of Beaumont for supporting her nomination and application for Ambassadorial Scholar. It was the opportunity of a lifetime.

Rebekah did not forget us while there. She presented numerous flags and memorabilia from quite a few European Rotary Clubs to our club President, Becky Mason. Rebekah is obviously proud of Rotary's support and confidence...and we believe she knows how proud we are of her.
