Robert Horry, Jr. is one of just two players to have won NBA championships with three different teams: two with the Houston Rockets, three with the Los Angeles Lakers and two with the San Antonio Spurs. He was known for his affinity for hitting big shots, especially in the playoffs. Because of his clutch shooting in important games, he has earned the nickname "Big Shot Rob."

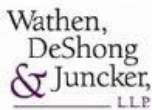

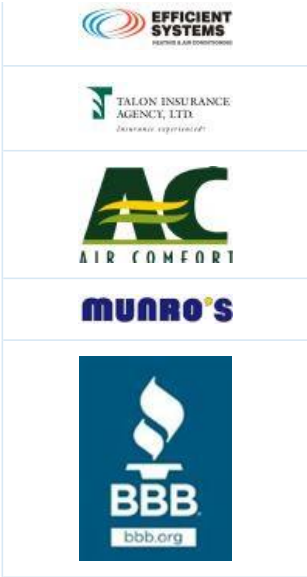

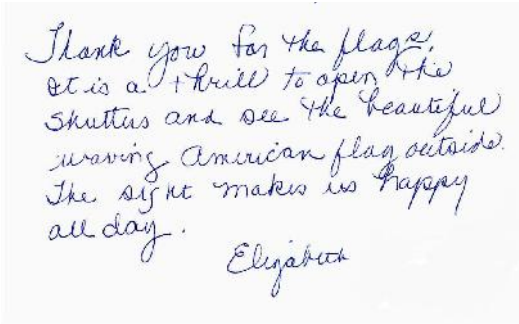
Once again, Rotarians answered the call and reported for their

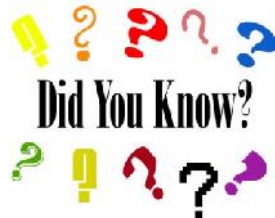

Gifts and donations to the Beaumont Rotary Foundation are invested locally and used by the club for annual projects such as the expenses of International service projects like the Layette project for mothers and children in Nicaragua, the youth scholarship program, and more. Gifts to the international Rotary Foundation are invested on an international basis and, after three years, 50% is returned to the District to support service efforts of the clubs.

On Saturday, District 5910 awarded 16 grants to clubs of the District for projects and service work, including \$2,500 the Rotary Club of Beaumont for the Nicaraguan Layette project.

PROGRAM REVIEW

September 12, 2012

"The Future of Space Travel"



Joe Mayer **Lockheed Martin Space Company**

The Rotary speaker on September 12 was Joe Mayer of Lockheed Martin Space Systems Company. Mr. Mayer was introduced by Past President Jim Rich and presented a Powerpoint presentation entitled "The Future of Space Travel."

NASA's transportation system, to take humans into deep space, will be based on designs originally planned for the Orion Crew Exploration Vehicle.

ORION has three 3 objectives:

1. Sub-Orbital - to integrate and fly technological payloads
2. Low Earth Orbit - for scientific discoveries benefitting life on earth and technological testing
3. Beyond Low Earth Orbit - human exploration and discoveries BEYOND Low Earth Orbit, further than humans have ever reached before!

ORION, America's new human exploration spacecraft, is made up of 4 sections:

- 1) Crew Module: the habitat
- 2) Launch Abort System: for launch-pad emergencies, etc.

- 3) Service Module: control and power
- 4) Spacecraft Adapter: structural interface (SLS)

The Crew Module, sitting on TOP of the spacecraft, has the capability of separating itself from the rest of the fusilage at a rate of 500 miles per hour, IF NECESSARY, should there be any launch-pad emergency.

Forty-two states have had some part in the development of ORION, which is 30% LARGER than Apollo Spacecrafts.

The Space Program is federally-funded, with one-half a percent of the national budget.
