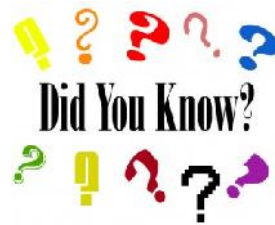

Robert Horry played in the NBA for 16 years and won championships with the Houston Rockets, San Antonio Spurs, and the L.A. Lakers. In all, he won 7 titles and is one of two players to have championships with 3 different teams. He earned the nickname "Big Shot Rob" because of his innate ability to make 3-point shots at clutch times during games.

He stated that the best player that he ever played against was Michael Jordan because of his fierce competitiveness and the second best was Kobe Bryant due to his work ethic. He stated that Rudy Tomjonavich was his favorite coach due to his caring nature for his players.

Robert Horry was well informed about our playground project and while discussing it, gave notice to a feature that perhaps none of us have thought about – a dual purpose playground is not just for children. It gives parents with disabilities the ability to play with their children on a playground. Disabled parents may not be able to play basketball with the children but they will be able to go to the playground and laugh, play and have a good time with their children.

The Rotary Club raised \$975 for the playground project by selling raffle tickets for two basketballs Robert autographed.
