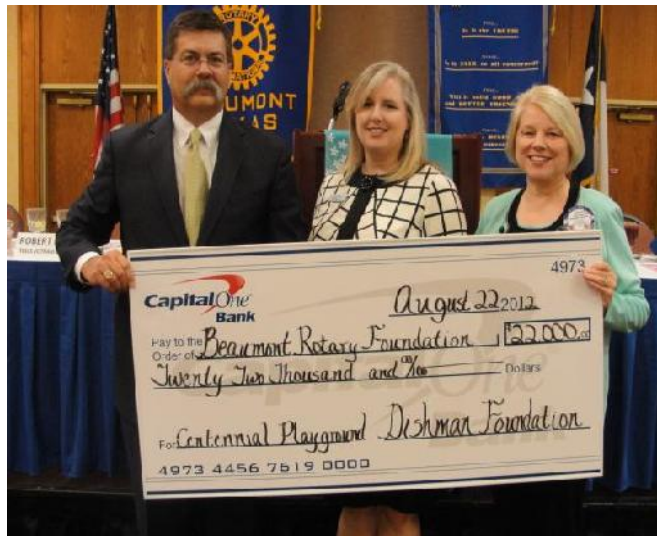


BEAUMONT ROTARY CENTENNIAL PLAYGROUND

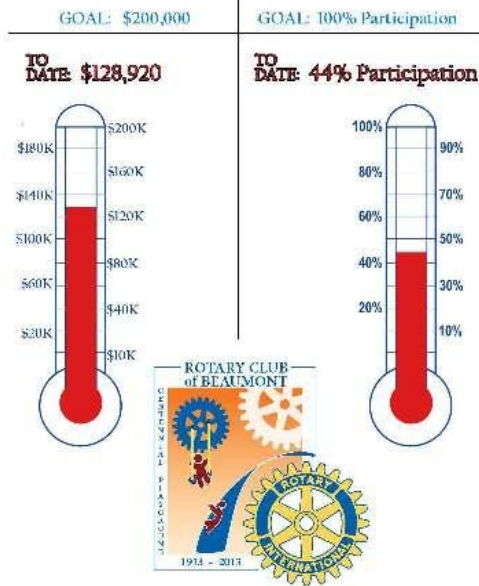

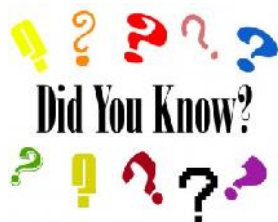
