

#### "Engage Rotary...Change Lives"





David Johnson Governor Rotary District 5910

Our speaker today was David Johnson, District 5910 Governor. Governor Johnson was introduced by Past District Governor Roger McCabe. In his introduction, Roger mentioned that he and Governor Johnson have been good friends since 1993.

Governor Johnson spoke about the two primary issues that surround the growth of Rotary Clubs and Rotary membership:

- 1) Attraction of new members
- 2) Retention of existing membership

Governor Johnson stated that the lack of retention is actually an effect rather not a cause. Lack of retention manifests when the members, new and old, do not feel connected or relevant in their Clubs. Govenor Johnson challenged us to perform the little things that mean so much. One solution can be found in a well-managed orientation process. What an excellent opportunity to expose the new member to the various "Lanes of Service."

An explanation of "Lanes of Service" from an enthused orientation committee member will make all the difference to the new Rotarian. Governor Johnson encouraged that a follow-up phone call to the new Rotarian after Orientation may enhance that "welcomed" feeling.

Meaningful projects, at home and abroad, gives the new Rotarian a much larger picture of what it means to be a Rotarian. The Four Way Test is not only the standard by which the existing membership conducts themselves. This has an immediate impact on our communities, and naturally ripples throughout the World. Governor Johnson stated, "No matter how much I give Rotary, I receive so much more."
