PROGRAM REVIEW September 4, 2013

"GSE is Quite a Learning Experience!"

Kris Benson, a member of our District 5910's Group Study Exchange Program, spoke about participating as a team member in the exchange with the Virgin Islands, District 7020. For those who don't have a history of this program, there is a Rotarian Team Leader (this year from the Cleveland Club) and then four non-Rotarians, chosen as team members, who represent our region for four weeks in another District. The team members are usually identified by Rotarians at clubs, and the members must be between the ages of 25 and 40. Members apply for acceptance and go through two interviews after which the District leadership announces the members

Kris was in four countries (British Virgin Islands, US Virgin Islands and St Martin's which is one-half Dutch and $\frac{1}{2}$ -French). The team traveled by boat, ferry and boat plane between the islands spending a week on each of the major islands. The District Conference for 7020 was held in St Martin's and the Texas State Flag flew from the capital in honor of our team.

For Kris, the cultural and business exchange had special meaning as he had worked on projects in the islands and he was able to spend time with those ventures. They were hosted by club members from the District, visited most of the clubs at a meeting, toured the islands, and exchanged cultural and business information. "It was a good professional exchange" and one that has encouraged Kris to become a Rotarian in Galveston. The team has a Facebook page with District 5910 GSE.
