


All ideas need to be turned into the office no later than October 15.

"Today's Beaumont Police Department"



Jimmy Singletary Chief of Police Beaumont Police Department, City of Beaumont

Our speaker today was Beaumont Chief of Police, Jimmy Singletary. Chief Singletary was introduced by Mayor Becky Ames, and as she did so, the Mayor graciously and warmly expressed her pride in our Chief.

After a long career in law enforcement, Chief Singletary started off by notifying Rotarians that, "I didn't come to this job...at my age...to learn anything new ... I am just trying to remember what I've already learned."

Chief Singletary played the latest recruitment DVD for the Beaumont Police Department, and repeated throughout his presentation

how very proud he is of the Beaumont Police Department. The BPD emblem contains the words "Honor, Dedication, Integrity"... which the Chief and his Department take seriously. The Chief stated that every major municipality has encountered their own share of challenges in their history, and Beaumont Police Department is no exception. The Chief is proud of the challenges that his Department has overcome, and that everyone strives to continue to improve.

Chief Singletary provided some statistics, beginning with "2012 By The Numbers":

- 7,943 arrests
- 3,947 Crash reports
- 278 DWI arrests
- 11,479 Animal Service Calls
- 17,111 Offense reports completed
- 52,780 Officer-initiated contacts
- 141,143 Calls for Service
- 22 Citizen complaints

The BPD has the following 3 year clearance rates :

- 88% for Homicide
- 71% for Rape
- 39% for Robbery
- 87% for Aggravated Assaults

\*All of these clearance rates EXCEED national rates.

The fact about Drugs: 95% of all crime is related to drugs:

- dealers selling
- users buying
- burglaries/assaults/robberies are methods used to get drugs
- users/addicts high when committing crimes

The Beaumont Police Force has FIVE full-time officers, dedicated to the Regional Task Force, which include the DEA, Homeland Security, ATF, the FBI, and the Department of Justice.

Chief Singletary recognized all the Departments' Captains and Lieutenants, as well as the Public Relations Team of Cindy Bloodsworth, and Sergeant Rob Flores. (The Chief did acknowledge that if we see him on the news, it is because Rob isn't doing his job.)

Chief James "Jimmy" Singletary is a wonderful example of the BPD Mission Statement: "Serving our community with integrity, fairness, and respect."
