- creative thinking

- Many of the smartest and most successful people have NOT been products of prestigious schools.

**Ten Deadly Entrepreneurial Sins/Beliefs**

- Founder does everything
- Believing one's own BS
- Compromised ethics
- Belief that our 'product' is omnipotent in marketplace
- Hiring CEO with NO business experience
- Faulty belief that "there is no competition"
- Faulty belief that Founder/CEO knows all, therefore, hires "inferiors"
