

Program Review

PROGRAM REVIEW July 8, 2015

"The Outlook for Energy:
A View to 2040"

Our speaker today was Jason Pettrey, Operations Support and Energy Improvement Department Head, Technical Division for ExxonMobil Beaumont Refinery. Ted Moor introduced him and received overwhelming, rousing applause from our membership.

In a presentation entitled, "The Outlook for Energy: A View To 2040", Jason presented a Powerpoint slideshow with a great deal of information.

Explaining energy measures and units in a manner everyone could understand, Jason presented the following:

- One standard log of wood equals 24,000 BTU's; and
- One gallon of gas equals five standard logs of wood.

#### Energy Demands (in the USA):

- Home ..... = 7 logs
- Auto ..... = 6 logs
- Industry ..... = 11 logs
- Commercial, etc.  $\dots = 10 + \log s$

#### Energy Demands Per Capita (USA vs. the World)

- 34.0 logs per capita .... vs .... 9.0 logs
- 7.0 gallons of gas... vs ... 1.7 gallons

Primary energy demands by sector:

- # 1 Industrial
- # 2 Transportation
- # 3 Residential/Commercial

Projected Growth From 2010 to 2040:

Oil - .8%

Gas - 1.6%

Coal - .1%

Biomass - .5%

Nuclear - 2.3%

Solar/ etc - 5.8%

Hydro/geo - 1.8%

Energy Supply (worldwide) by type:

#1 - biofuels

# 2 - other

# 3 - natural gas

#4 - tight oil

#5 - oil sands

# 6 - deepwater/Arctic drilling

#7 - conventional crude & condensate

It is the developing economies that will dominate energy growth until 2040.

Jason opened the floor for questions. Leonard Juncker asked, "What will we rely on when we have exhausted our planet's supply of carbon?" Jason replied, "Our technology."
