Mission

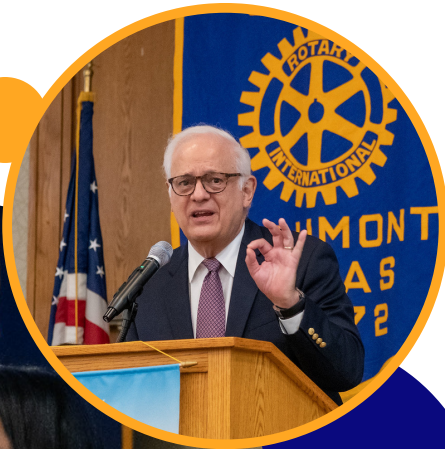
