Applications are now being accepted.

Teachers in Cupertino, Lynbrook, Monta Vista, Fremont and Homestead high schools are eligible to receive one-time grants in the amount of \$50.00 to \$300.00 to purchase classroom materials or to implement programs that might otherwise go unfunded.

Teachers must request grants **individually**. No group applications. A teacher can apply for one mini-grant per funding cycle.

Amount of Grant

Mini-grants will be awarded in the amounts from \$50.00 to \$300.00.

Application Deadline

Grants will be awarded once during the academic year. The application deadline is January 8, 2021.

Who is Eligible

Teachers in Cupertino, Lynbrook, Monta Vista, Fremont and Homestead high schools may apply for grants. Teachers must request grants **individually**. Teachers are eligible to apply for one mini-grant per funding cycle.

Application Procedure
