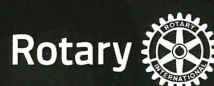

The Bryan Rotary Club designed the Bryan Rotary 10 Business Performance Awards as a community economic development program. Originally introduced in 1994 as the Newman 10 Awards, the program annually recognizes and honors businesses located in Brazos County, both small and large, for their achievements and the significant impact they have on the local economy. The program reflects the respect Rotarians have for all useful occupations and for the value of productive work.

Since 2016, ANCO Insurance, a HUB International company, has been the primary financial underwriter.

Anyone may nominate a business. After being nominated, an application is completed, signed by a CPA and submitted for calculation of annual growth based on the percentage increase of gross sales. The top 10 businesses are then ranked based on these percentages.

A qualified applicant must be an independent, privately held corporation, sole proprietorship or partnership that has been in business for at least five years. The company's headquarters must be located in Brazos County, and have sales greater than \$50,000 but less than \$25 million in fiscal year 2024. They must demonstrate a five-year sales history with an increase from 2023 to 2024. Franchises are not eligible.

The prestigious Bryan Rotary 10 Awards are presented annually to the top 10 fastest-growing businesses at an annual Awards Luncheon. Also presented at the Luncheon since 1999 is the Bryan Rotary/ANCO Insurance Award for Lifetime Business Achievement. The ANCO Award is given to a mature business with a history of success and respect in its industry, and has significantly contributed to the quality of life in the community through the years.

The Greater Brazos Partnership also presents their Launch Award, recognizing a new business for leadership and significant impact on the community

# CONGRATULATIONS TO THE WINNER OF *The 2025 ANCO Insurance Award for Lifetime Business Achievement – Kent Moore Cabinets*

Kent Moore, founder of Kent Moore Cabinets (KMC), grew up moving often as the son of a Presbyterian minister. By the time he reached high school, Kent had lived in 12 different homes, including a stop in Alaska. Many of these homes were owned by small churches and in constant need of repair, sparking Kent's early interest in carpentry—a skill he honed by working alongside his father.

In 1972, as a junior at Texas A&M, Kent founded what would become Texas's largest custom cabinet manufacturer. What began in a duplex apartment has grown into an operation with 650 employees, two manufacturing plants in Bryan, nine design centers across Texas, and \$144 million in annual sales. Kent's business philosophy is simple. "The 10 keys to running a successful business are: #1 Quality, #2 Service... and the other eight don't matter," he says.

Kent's path to success was not without deep sacrifice during difficult economic periods. During the 2008 recession, he sold personal assets to ensure KMC could weather the storm and keep employees paid. KMC is family-run business; Kent's son Casey serves as President and CEO, while his sons-in-law, Kenny Bolline and Shawn Locke, serve as Executive VPs. KMC works with some of the most respected homebuilders in the nation, including David Weekley Homes, Toll Brothers, and Highland Homes as well as directly serving customers who are building custom homes.

## KMC's Distinctive Strengths Include:

- **Commitment to Quality and Craftsmanship:** Kent often points to cabinets he built nearly five decades ago that are still in use today.
- **Exceptional Customer Service:** In the wake of Hurricane Harvey, KMC stepped up to help flood victims, even if they weren't original customers, which embodies KMC's culture of empathy and reliability.
- **Resilience and Grit:** KMC has survived everything from bankruptcy to natural disasters like an F3 tornado and Hurricane Harvey.
- **Operational Excellence:** Kent implemented systems and processes that allowed KMC to scale production while maintaining quality, such as jumping from 600 to 950 cabinets a day after Hurricane Harvey.
- **Innovation and Technology:** Kent and Casey embraced technology and system advancements to keep KMC efficient and competitive.
- **Employee-Centered Culture:** Even in hard times, Kent maintained a deep care for his team, as evidenced by the tenure of his employees. His executive team has 281 combined years of service, with the average tenure being 28 years. The expanded leadership team averages 21 years of service.

Community support is a cornerstone of KMC's legacy, with regular contributions to the College Station Education Foundation, SOS Ministries, OnRamp, the Brazos Valley Food Bank and the Alzheimer's Association. Kent's strong faith and commitment to integrity have built lasting trust with customers and employees. As for being selected as the 2025 recipient of the ANCO Lifetime Achievement, Kent reflects on his journey with humility, saying, *"Success comes not just from building cabinets, but from building a life of integrity, perseverance, and service."*

# Crystal Clear Cleaning LLC

Crystal Clear Cleaning, LLC, was founded in 2018 by Lauren Galls and Robert Mandujano. Lauren and Robert recognized a gap in the janitorial services market while working for another business, and when their own office’s janitorial service failed to complete tasks, Lauren would step in to maintain cleanliness. These insights spurred the creation of Crystal Clear Cleaning, currently a certified Texas HUB business program with certifications through OSHA Academy and the National CPR Foundation.

Starting as a small operation, Lauren and Robert handled all cleaning tasks themselves while working their full-time jobs. Their first major contract was secured in March 2019, cleaning a 14,000 square- foot building. Operating initially from their apartment, they washed towels and stored supplies at home. The turning point came in August 2019, when they won the janitorial bid for Bryan Texas Utilities. This success enabled them to quit their full-time jobs and focus entirely on Crystal Clear Cleaning.

The COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 brought an unexpected boost to their business, highlighting the critical importance of cleanliness. They took on disinfecting tasks for the Bryan Fire Department and Robertson County Courthouse. They purchased their first fleet vehicle in March 2022 and expanded to 25 employees. In August 2022, they moved into their first office and warehouse space, a significant milestone that accommodated their rapid growth. Crystal Clear recently renewed their agreement with BTU and added the City of Bryan to their list of clients.

Now with 74 employees, they have been able to add new roles such as product delivery drivers and dedicated office personnel. “We have focused on building the custodial products to our service line,” Robert explained, “and are able to provide clients with the custodial products they need in addition to the cleaning of their facilities.”

The company’s sparkling diamond logo and a catchy tagline of “If you want your business to shine like a diamond, give us a ring” describe their drive to provide quality service and products to make their clients’ facilities sparkle. Lauren and Robert believe in investing in employees, fostering a supportive workplace, and maintaining strong client relationships. Their commitment to community involvement is reflected in their active participation in the Chamber of Commerce, the Hispanic Forum, SARC (Sexual Assault Resource Center) and their support of St. Joseph Catholic Church.

Crystal Clear Cleaning LLC is a repeat winner of the BR10, coming in at #8 in 2024. Moving up to #2 in 2025 is a testament to their rate of growth. Lauren, a graduate of Sam Houston State University, was excited for Crystal Clear to be named by the 2024 “Bearkat 79 Awards Program” as #4 out of 79 fastest growing SHSU alumni-owned businesses.

Carney's Pub is a local "Cheers-style" neighborhood pub and grill located at 3410 South College in Bryan. Since 2010, owner Barry Ivins has worked to create a space where people of all ages can meet new friends and neighbors. After purchasing the pub, Barry renovated the building and currently employs 30 people, several of whom have been with him for many years, along with many part-time students.

As the business evolved during the COVID-19 shutdown in 2020, the property expanded to include multiple large patio areas, enabling it to accommodate a larger crowd both indoors and outdoors. The expansion also features a children's play area, fostering a family-friendly environment. Regular events include Wednesday Karaoke and Trivia Nights, as well as Crawfish Sundays. They have also added a pub menu, and with the rise in popularity of craft beers, they introduced 46 beer taps with beer brand rotations every Wednesday.

As the City of Bryan has developed and revitalized, new multi-family homes have been built in the neighborhood, attracting new patrons. The influx of visitors to Big Shots, Aggie events, Legends Event Center, Bomber baseball games, the increasing student populations at local Blinn and Texas A&M campuses have contributed to the success of local businesses, including Carney's. Barry says his biggest challenge today is meeting the demand created by all of this growth.

When asked how he feels about being recognized as one of the fastest-growing small businesses in the Brazos Valley, Barry said "I believe I still have much to learn." He emphasizes staying humble and making his family his top priority. He says that one of the keys to his success is his staff, stressing the importance of teamwork and fostering a culture that allows his staff to grow. He has learned not to micromanage and to give the staff room to develop. "We all make mistakes, but we should learn from them," he said.

Carney's Pub and Grill has a guiding mission: to be the heart of our community, fostering connections through exceptional hospitality, quality offerings, and a celebration of local culture. "With integrity and a commitment to continuous improvement, we create memorable experiences, support important causes, and enrich the lives of our patrons while strengthening our neighborhood," Barry said.

Over the years, Barry has been involved with the Cattle Barons Ball, the Chamber of Commerce, and the Bryan Midtown Committee, and he currently coaches T-Ball teams for 5- and 7-year-olds. He and his wife participated in Leadership Brazos. Advice he would give to other small businesses? Barry says to embrace technology, and do not fear change. He emphasizes that "Change is normal, and I am grateful to the City of Bryan and its future planning."



# Kyle Estates dba Polite Coffee Roasters

Polite Coffee is a partnership among Steve Turner, Barry Ivins and Ali Ivins. Before they met, Steve started with a food truck while an Army Ranger and was set to deploy to Afghanistan when he learned that he had also been accepted into Texas A&M University. While in Afghanistan, he realized how he missed Texas and drinking coffee. After returning to Bryan and graduating from A&M and the Bush School, Steve continued roasting his own coffee and selling at the downtown Bryan farmer's market.

Barry had already begun his coffee shop journey with Gogh Gogh Coffee in College Station and owned the historic Kyle House in Bryan. In 2019, just before the pandemic, Steve and Barry met and decided to join forces to establish Polite Coffee at the Kyle House, making their own pastries, scones and "Politetarts" and roasting their own coffee beans. The vision was to create a coffee company that embodied Texas friendliness and produced outstanding specialty coffee without being condescending. The name Polite reflects this mission, as in their tagline: "If there is one thing you can do today, be Polite."

Steve says a key to their success is resilience, saying "like falling off a horse, you get back on." He has studied the coffee process, from the initial stages of selecting the beans to the cup of coffee that their guests enjoy. Barry says his role at Polite is to be a salesman, whereas at Carney's Pub and Grill the salespeople come to him. Polite Coffee blends and single-origin coffees are now available at three HEB grocery stores, at four locations on the Texas A&M campus and at many local restaurants.

Polite Coffee has a philosophy of simply treating people well, both guests and staff. Their philosophy aligns with Carney's Pub & Grill, also owned by Barry, to be the heart of the community, fostering connections through exceptional hospitality, quality offerings and a celebration of local culture.

Their philanthropic focus is on profit-sharing with local non-profit organizations, churches and student groups. The company employs both full-time and part-time staff members, and their college student employees are encouraged to participate in various philanthropic contributions. Steve and Barry donate coffee to the Big Event and support veteran organizations, by donating a coffee brewer to the Bryan VA Clinic as well as conducting fundraisers for Brazos Valley Cares.

When asked about their feelings on being recognized as one of the fastest-growing small businesses in the Brazos Valley, both emphasize the importance of remaining humble. Although meeting the growing demand is their biggest challenge today, a key lesson learned is that growth is gradual and cumulative, reinforcing the importance of persistence and confidence in their plans.

Their advice to other small business owners is to maintain a sense of community. The focus over the past year has been on enhancing bakery processes, including baked goods for Carney's Pub, expanding the venue for small events, and increasing the variety of events and food offered at the new Grove on the Texas A&M campus.

Trevor was already working in the industry, and when that company sold, the dream to build a family business was born. His wife Jenna, a 2011 A&M grad in biomedical science, says, "My family had their own business, and Trevor had the experience; he had his certified applicator's license, so we so we decided to start a business together." Trevor adds, "We started out with zero customers... it is hard, we went all in. There's no vacation when you begin to work for yourself."

The company has grown since Arrow S was named #8 in the 2022 BR10, now with a staff of 11 and with a greater ability to provide better pay and an enhanced work environment. Trevor explains, "You have to add people to add routes. " The addition of office support has helped to maintain their top notch customer service.

Jenna, who is also a certified pest control technician, says they treat both customers and employees like part of the family. "Our customers are very important to us; we know most by name and want to keep it that way," she says. "We're a husband and wife team and as we add new employees it is extremely important to maintain our family feel. We get along well and do things together outside of work... attending events, company parties, just having fun as a team."

Their tips for business owners? "You can never do it all and make everyone happy," says Jenna. "It's important to take care of your employees as well as you take care of your customers. We've been blessed so far in finding good people. You have your expectations, but you have to figure out their strengths and experience levels." Trevor adds, "You'll never hire yourself again!" Their key to success is their culture, focused on the "Do What's Right" motto: doing the right thing the first time. Each employee is to understand the expectation that customers will receive what they need, every time.

Binford Insect Control, Inc. was founded 78 years ago by Brien's grandfather, George Binford. "He saw the need for pest control services after being involved in some federal funded Mosquito Vector Control Programs with the State in Grimes County in 1946," Brien explains. "When the state phased these programs out in early 1947, he realized there still was a need, so he started doing pest control." The business has always been run and operated by family, now employing the 4<sup>th</sup> generation of Binfords. George's two sons, Bill Binford and Ed Binford continued his legacy, continuing to run the company the way he meant it to be. Now, Brien Binford has taken over the company and his son Blake joined in, bringing the total to 13 employees.

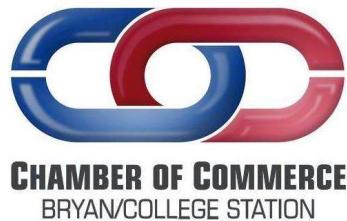
