WHAT ARE DISTRICT GRANTS?

- DG are block grants to districts that fund scholarships, projects, and travel that align with the mission of TRF, which is to enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty



Areas of Focus



Peace and conflict prevention/resolution



Disease prevention and treatment



Water and sanitation



Maternal and child health



Basic education and literacy



Economic and community development



PROCESS



- Select project
- Get Club buy-in with funds to match grant-can request \$3000 max. from the District
- Research project
- Obtain grant writer
- Plan budget
- Write Grant
- Obtain the funding
- Execute the project asap
- Complete Project Report before the deadline

Timeline

- Project report due with photos, receipts invoices, copies of checks, and publicity WERE Due: **April 1, 2014** (Grants - Don Taylor's year)
- Grant Requests for 2015-2016 due **15 May**
- To be completed by 15 **March**
- Report due **1 April**



GRANT PROCESS

1. Research and Plan Project
2. Apply for Grant on Clubrunner (plan financing and Balanced Budget)
3. Implement Project with due diligence
4. File Report on Clubrunner with all receipts, copies of checks, publicity and photos

REMEMBER

- Make sure your club has contributed equal or greater funds to the grant request
- Make sure all expenses are allowed by Rotary
- Make sure your request complies with all the criteria
- Make sure your budget is balanced- the expensed on the grant equal the income
- Check your final report to be sure all the questions are answered on Clubrunner and that the invoices, copies of checks, photos and receipts are uploaded onto Clubrunner before the deadline.
- Be sure to apply for funding for 2015-2016
