This scholarship will be paid out at the rate of \$1000 per year (\$500 per semester) over 4 years. The scholarship recipient will need to furnish a copy of the enrollment/class schedule at an accredited Institution of Higher Education to the Friendswood Rotary Treasurer each semester. Confirmation of enrollment is required to receive funds for years 2-4.

To apply for the scholarship, complete the attached application form and submit with 2 letters of recommendation via email to Cassie McGarvey at cmcgarvey@mcgarveypllc.com by May 1, 2025. The letters of recommendation cannot be from relatives or friends; they should be from someone that can vouch for your character and your commitment to your education. (i.e.: teachers, youth directors, employers, counselors, etc.) You may attach additional sheets as necessary to respond to the questions.

The winner of the Friendswood Rotary Interact Scholarship will be announced on May 9, 2025. The scholarship will be presented at the Friendswood Rotary Club meeting on May 14, 2024, beginning at noon at Hope Lutheran Church.
