Meeting Attendance

Members commit to attending weekly meetings every Tuesday at 12:00 p.m. Members may not miss four consecutive meetings without an excuse from the board of directors for good and sufficient reason. Members may also remain in good standing by making up missed meetings at any other Rotary club. Notice must be given to the Rotary Club of Galveston Island's secretary by the secretary of the club where the member attended to make up his/her absence. Makeup attendances must be timely in relation to the absence. For instance, if you miss the club's regular Tuesday meeting, you should make up the absence before the club's next regular meeting. All members are encouraged to achieve perfect attendance by avoiding absences and making absences up when necessary.

Financial Commitment

Members are obligated to pay for dues and meals on a quarterly basis. Each quarterly charge of \$275.00 covers local club dues, weekly lunches as well as all Rotary International member expenses. Quarterly billing dates are July 1, October 1, January 1 and April 1. Please remit payment within 10 days from the date of the bill. The first bill is prorated for new members based upon when they join the club. Additionally, new members are responsible for an initiation fee. Both of these fees must be paid in full to become an active member.

Orientation & Badge

New members of the Rotary Club of Galveston Island receive a temporary red badge. Fully vested members wear a blue badge. In order to transition to a blue badge, a new member must achieve the following:

- I. Pay initiation fee and current quarter prorated meals and dues in full
- II. Attend a minimum of four consecutive weekly meetings
- III. Attend one Rotary of Galveston Island board meeting
- IV. Participate in a quarterly orientation meeting facilitated by the membership director
