The Grand Baby Project

Twenty-nine years old and married for only eight months, Leah Stanley was suddenly thrust into the role of primary caregiver for her grandparents, who were both diagnosed with dementia at the same time. Leah shares her caregiving story in her book, *Goodnight Sweet: A Caregiver's Long Goodbye*, a 2022 Firebird Book Award winner. In 2023, she released her book's educational companion piece, *Caring for a Loved One with Alzheimer's or Other Dementia: Everything I Wish I Had Known*, a Best Book Awards finalist. Leah is a keynote, conference & workshop speaker, and she is certified in dementia doll therapy, educating health care and other professionals about the work of The Grand Baby Project. She lives with her family in Houston, Texas.
