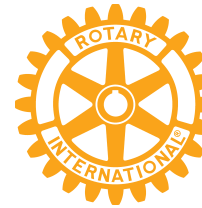

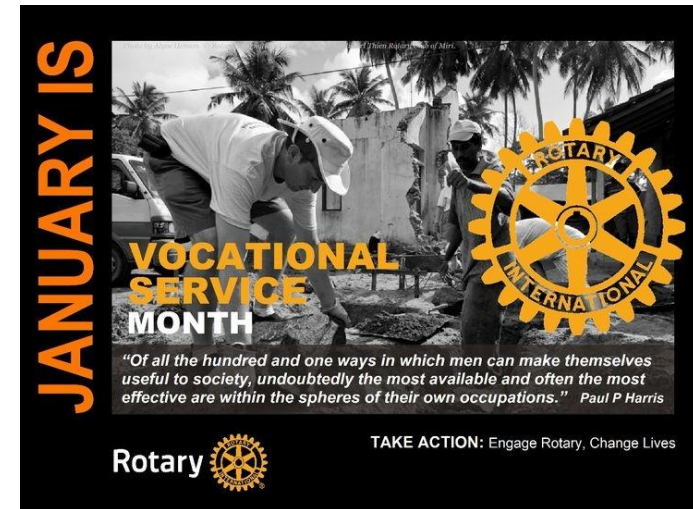
## Program: Tammy Sykes Gulf Coast Trnsit District
