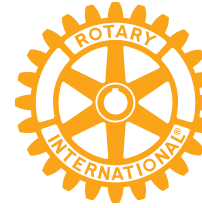

Hold on to your meatball and don't ever sneeze.

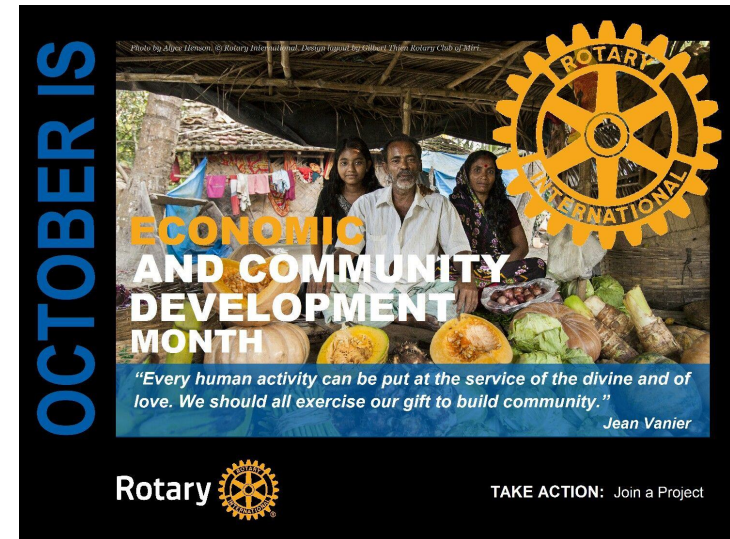
