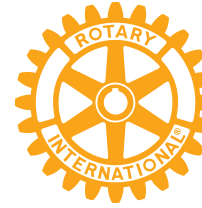

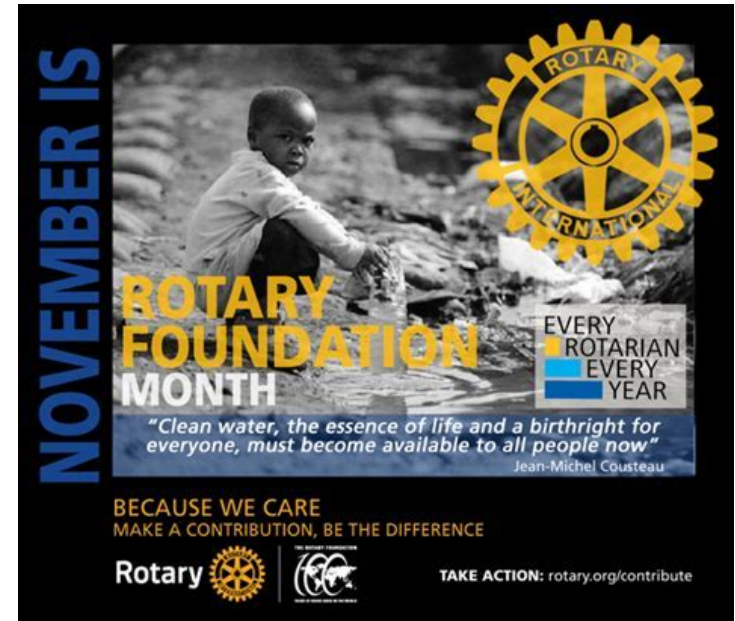
Program: Doryn Danner Glenn Jury & Court Scams

In 2007, Glenn left private practice and began her career in judicial support in the Galveston County District Clerk's office, serving in a number of roles and as the District Clerk in 2012. She currently serves as Chief Deputy for District Clerk John D. Kinard, where she manages the jury system for Galveston County, among other things. She has served as the President of the Galveston County Bar Association, the Galveston County Young Lawyers Association and the Junior League of Galveston County. She is a Charter member of the Galveston County Adoption Day Foundation where she currently serves as the Treasurer of the Board of Directors. She has also served as the Chair of the Jury Service Committee of the State Bar of Texas. She currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Galveston County Bar Association. She is the proud mother of a 27 year old daughter, (who is a 3rd grade teacher), and a 23 year old son, (an Eagle Scout who is a college student at Texas A&M University in Galveston).
