PALESTINE ROTARY CLUB HISTORY, contd

In 1948, the club inaugurated its very successful Rotary *Jersey Calf Project* helping to interest farmers in dairying rather than raising cotton. A registered Jersey calf was given away to start a milk herd with the stipulation the first heifer calf was returned to the "heifer pool" and given to another farmer. The original investment on the project was \$6,000.
