The following is a Palestine City Ordinance adopted in February 1873 ORDINANCE XVII

Section 1st. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, that immediate steps be taken to procure a house or building near and adjoining said town as will best serve for a smallpox hospital, and that a Health officer be appointed whose duty it shall be to examine and inspect all persons upon each and every train from Longview or other infected points to ascertain if there be any small pox among such persons, and if he finds persons infected with small pox stopping at the depot at this place, to have such person or persons removed at once to the small pox hospital for treatment and care.

And further that the Board of Aldermen or a majority of said Board, are constituted a standing committee to aid and assist the Health officer in the discharge of his duties and procure such provisions as may be necessary for use of said small pox hospital

And further that the Board of Aldermen or a majority of said Board, are constituted a standing committee to aid and assist the Health officer in the discharge of his duties and procure such provisions as may be necessary for use of said small pox hospital.

Section 2nd. Should the smallpox make its appearance in any family in said town, the head of such family shall cause to stuck up a placard upon which shall be written in plain and conspicuous letters, "Smallpox here." so that persons may be warned not to enter such premises. And any such head of family failing to place such placard so written upon in front of their premises so soon as aware of smallpox being in their family shall be fined one hundred dollars and imprisonment at the discretion of the Mayor.

Section 3rd. All physicians are requested and required to report every Friday morning of each week the number and character of diseases they have treated within said town, to the Health officer, so that published reports of the health of the town may be had.

That the above ordinance be in force and effect from and after its adoption. Adopted Feby 13th AD 1873
