On Tuesday evening, June 3rd, 1913, the Rotary Club of Palestine held its first meeting. Some 20 members were present. The group, which had been called together by Harry I. Myers, met at the Interstate dining room in the International Hotel. Myers, a Palestine native, ad come back home in 1912 from San Antonio to join members of his family at the Grand Leader Department store. Perhaps he had heard of the Rotary Club organized in 1912 in San Antonio Club officers were elected with

twenty-nine year old Myers as club president. The newspaper article about that meeting states that “the object of the Rotary Club is to promote social relations between business men.”
