### Mayor Steve Presley "City of Palestine Update"

The City of Palestine is the county seat for Anderson County, Texas and has a population of approximately 18,712 per the 2010 U.S. Census. The City operates under a Council-Manager form of government with a Mayor, six (6) Council Members, and a City Manager. The Council Members are elected from single member districts, with the Mayor elected at large. The City Manager is the Chief Executive Officer of the City. It is the City Manager's duty to execute and implement policies as established by the City Council

## PALESTINE ROTARY CLUB HISTORY, contd

Our club, still in its early years continued to meet in the Interstate Restaurant until March 1915, when the Redlands Hotel was formally opened. The Rotary Club held its first "open" meeting as a ladies-night-out event in the newly completed building, and held its subsequent meetings in the Redlands until 1919 when the building was converted to General Office for the railroad.
