On April 12, 1955, scientists declared Jonas Salk's polio vaccine safe, effective, and potent. In honor of the anniversary of that historic announcement, RI General Secretary John Hewko delivered a speech at the World Vaccine Congress in Washington, D.C., noting Rotary's leadership role in polio eradication.

And what do we do? We eradicate polio. We do other things too, of course, but Rotary's highest priority is the eradication off polio.
