Weekly Update A roundup of Rotary news



Rotary will be helping to train engineers and scientists to solve problems in water and sanitation, particularly in developing countries, through a new strategic partnership between the Rotary Foundation and UNESCO-IHE Institute for Water Education. Through the partnership, the Foundation will offer packaged grants that Rotary clubs may use to select and sponsor scholarships for professionals in the water sector. Up to eight students a year may be chosen for any of three master of science programs at the institute in Delft, the Netherlands.
