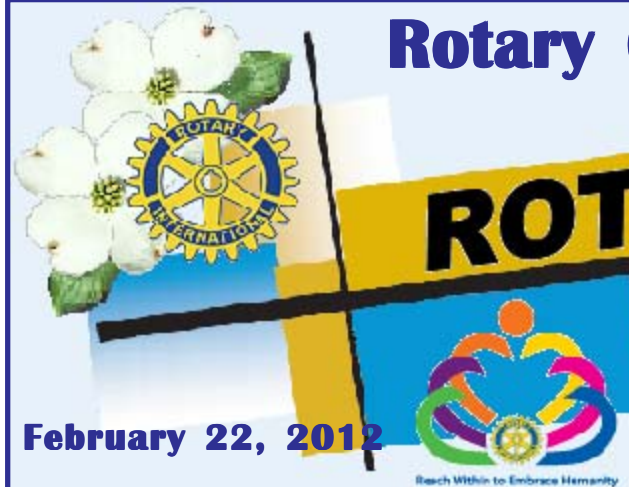

One year after the terrorist attacks of 9/11, the first class of Rotary Peace Fellows began their studies. Since then, more than 590 fellows have gone on to build peace in their communities and nations, as well as across international lines.

They include graduates of a two-year master's degree program and a three-month professional certificate program at Rotary's partner universities.
