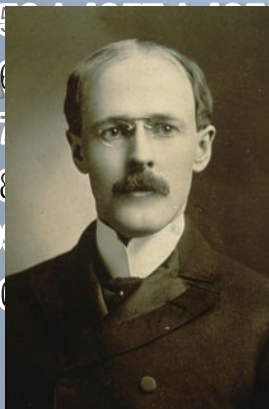

The train is running local rides on a regular basis from both Palestine and Rusk. Studies have convinced all involved that the Special Events Rides are the key to bringing in large crowds and such programs as **Polar Express**, **Thomas, Great Pumpkin**, have proven to be one of the keys to the mounting success of the Park.

Steve briefed us on the **Iowa-Pacific Tourist & Freight** plan to connect to the **Union Pacific** lines and to enable the handling of a special class of railroad freight in our local yards. It promises to be a new and huge dimension for the Texas State Railroad. We owe our thanks to **Steve and the other Board members** who have worked tirelessly on our behalf.

LIGHT EXPERT ENTERTAINS THE LOCAL ROTARIANS

The Rotary club enjoyed an entirely unique and unusual program today, and thanks to Howard S. Ware, manager of Texas Power & Light Company, who had charge of the program, who introduced D. J. Finn, with the Edison Lamp Works of the General Electric Company. Mr. Finn talked for some fifteen minutes on proper lighting, using various kinds of light globes to illustrate his talk. He convinced most Rotarians that he knew a great deal about lighting that most people didn't know, and he also convinced everyone who heard him that there is a lot of difference in lights. The talk was one of the most interesting heard by the Rotarians in many months. On motion of Luckett Kolstad, it was voted to have the Rotarians challenge the Lions club for a baseball game, as a

means of raising money for the student loan fund. The challenge will be issued at once, and if accepted, which it will no doubt be, a game will be arranged at as early date as possible.
