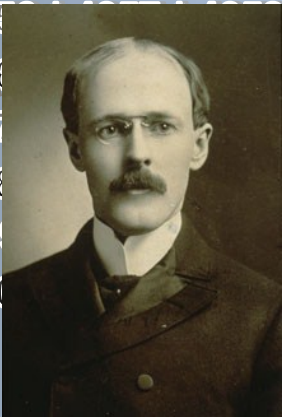
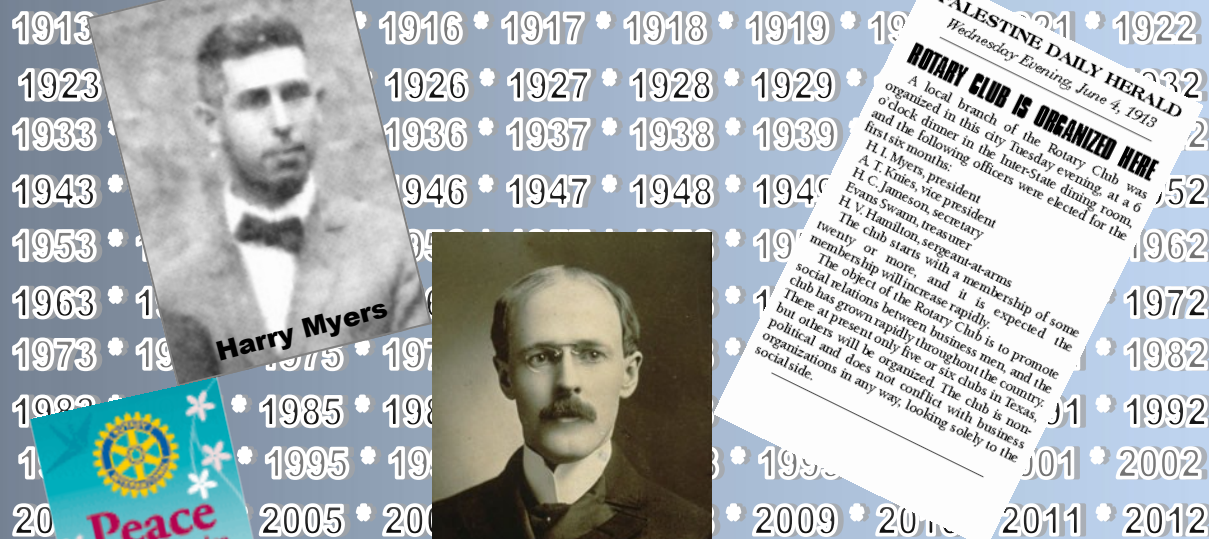

Jan. A similarity in telephone numbers was causing a flood of calls to the Bob Gruetzner home from persons throughout the United States trying to reach millionaire James Brody, Jr., of New York, who had been reported giving money away to people in trouble.
Feb. Contractors began widening of Mallard and Church Streets, which were to be converted to one-way traffic thoroughfares once construction was completed.
April. Palestine business and civic leader **K. A. Anderson** was honored for distinguishing service to the people of Palestine for a period of more than 30 years. The recognition came during a joint luncheon meeting of the city=s civic clubs held in observance of Texas Industrial Week.
May. The Murray Corporation, Palestine=s newest industry, held open house at its new facility here.
June. The **East Texas National Bank** was robbed of \$5400 by an armed bandit who demanded money of drive-in window teller, Mrs. Olive Hinson.
Sept. Missouri Pacific Railroad=s once crack passenger train, the Texas Eagle, made its last run through Palestine, marking the end of passenger service for the city.
Dec. The Palestine City Council changed the method of billing for sewer service. They will now be based on the amount of water used rather than the number of sewer fixtures as in the past

The coach told of the introduction and success of a **Boot Camp** for members of the football team. In his words, it has been a **"difference maker."** While quick to say that it does not solve all problems, he did state that it has drastically improved the outlook and attitude of team members, and better equipped them not only for the games they play, but for the lives they lead. That's quite a deal.
The coach shared with the club how this technique helps these young men "get out of their comfort zones," and become more capable of facing the adversities of life with success. It goes way beyond the games.
They also stress **TPW**, which the players and coaches wear with pride. **Tough People Win**. Not so much physically tough as mentally tough in facing and managing problems. As he say, "Tough times never last, but tough people do."
The players have bonded together and now are motivated to actively help one another and others. This form of **Character Training** provides a bed rock for many young people—a mental discipline that they will carry with them into adulthood. The coach says it is a life-changer for many of the players.
Great work, coach. We **all** learned from your presentation.

An innovation was beginning the luncheon with grace, President **Eugene Fish** calling on **Mark Hamilton** for that service. There were several visitors-among those being introduced were Pace McDonald, **Walter Myers, J. W. Crotty, R. E. Montgomery, John Reed, Neal Hostetter, Mr. McFarland and George Holcomb.**
Mr. Crotty is head of the Ligo Chemical Co., now operating the coal mine west of the city.

Mr. Reed is the new manager of the Gem, and promises good entertainment and clean shows. **Mr. Hostetter**, who is to be manager of the **O'Neill**, Palestine's new hotel, modestly told of the opening to take place June 1. **Mr. Montgomery**, president of the Business League, is often a visitor, and should be a member. He says so himself. **Mr. Holcomb**, formerly lived here, and told of his great surprise when he rolled onto the North Jackson street paving, coming via auto from Cleburne. Said he knew it was the right street in the right town; but it did not look the same.

President Eugene Fish asked for nominations for directors, and **Osie Rogers** and **Mark Hamilton** being nominated, were elected directors for the coming year. **John McDonald** was elected sergeant at arms.
