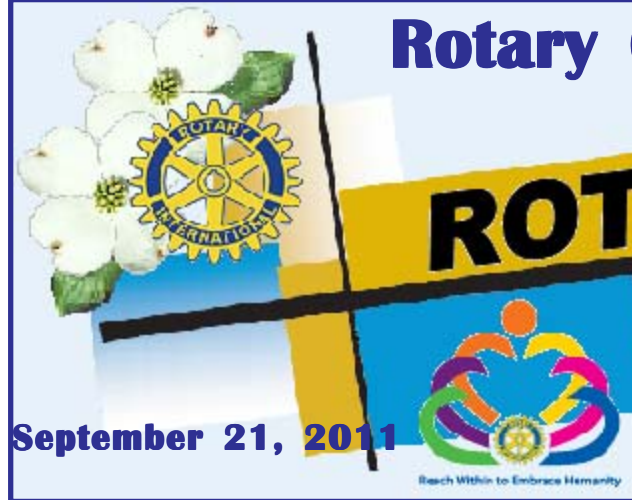

What Happened Last Week

State Representative Byron Cook gave us some of the details about this session of the Texas Legislature. He began by encouraging us all to pray for rain, and to be cautious in this dangerous dry environment.



Representative Cook admitted that this was a very difficult session in many ways. He was generally pleased that the Legislature and Governor were able to craft a workable budget, despite the economic difficulties. School funding, which occupies over 60% of the budget, remains a problem for nearly every school district, though the cuts have not been as drastic as first forecast. Nursing Home funding was also preserved.

Cook spoke of several of the session's successes on such diverse matters as eminent domain, Windstorm insurance, Voter ID, Texas Youth Commission, control of copper theft, and Ag exemptions. He also mentioned some areas where he was dissatisfied with the outcome, particularly on the matter of texting while driving which was ultimately vetoed by the Governor.

New member Meghan Hill was introduced by her sponsor, Sloan Shuffler. Vice President Mike officially inducted her into our club, and Sloan presented Meghan with her pin and red badge. Good going Mike and Sloan, and welcome Meghan. We are all glad to have you with us.
