





















TODAYS PROGRAM



The world is making good progress in this area. According to a 2014 United Nations
Millennium Development Goals progress report, literacy rates among adults and youths
are on the rise and the gender gap in literacy is narrowing. But pressing global needs

58 million children worldwide are out of school.

- Even after four years of primary schooling, as many as 250 million children cannot read and write.
- 781 million adults are illiterate.
