Overview of Request for Proposals: the Nampa Rotary Community fund is requesting proposals for projects up to \$500.00 from non-profit organizations in the Nampa community. Nampa Rotary Community fund grants, up to five per year, will be awarded to selected non-profit organizations early in December. Proposals must be submitted by the third Tuesday of November to the address below.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- All grantees must be a registered non-profit organization and provide a Tax ID #.
- Must provide a one page summary of the project that you are requesting funds for, including application cover page and separate budget outline as to how the funds will be spent. Proposals must be submitted no later than the third Tuesday of November at 5 p.m.
- Proposals will be reviewed and scored by the Nampa Rotary Community Fund Board and organizations will be notified.
- If your non-profit organization is awarded a \$500 Nampa Rotary Community Fund, you cannot submit another proposal for funding to the Nampa Rotary Community Fund the following year.
