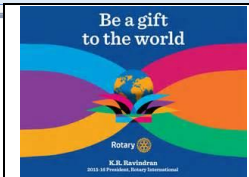

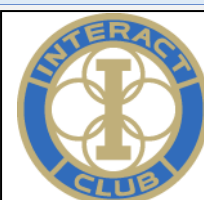

Let's have the best year ever demonstrating Service Above Self. Let the fun times begin! Welcome Michele.

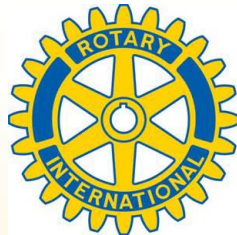

PROJECT SANCTUARY

Several Rotarians have expressed an interest in seeing what happens at Project Sanctuary. We have two opportunities in August.

On **Friday, August 14th** the crew from Project Sanctuary will be at Sam's Club in Lone Tree at 9:15 a.m. and need help loading the groceries and supplies into their vehicle and then drive (car pool) to the YMCA Camp in Granby, CO to unload the groceries, unload the storage closet, unload the bus, and help set up the lodge for the retreat and get Orientation Packets together and make name tags). Then drive back home.

Maximum 5 Rotarians.

On **Saturday, August 15th** – you can drive to Granby, CO and see some of what the veterans and their families do on a retreat. You would need to be at camp by 8:30 a.m. (eat before you come) then follow the caravan to the reservoir to see the fishing set up and help set up lunch. Next would be off to the stables for a send-off to the families for their trail rides and possible help play with kiddos. From there you can go back and see the areas where all the activities are held and then drive back home. **Maximum 5 Rotarians.**

Want to help, but don't have the time? You could make **HOMEMADE** cookies or brownies to be delivered to the camp with the group on Friday or Saturday.
