#### **Polio Plus Update**

The Rotary Club of Parker had 51 members give a total of \$3250 to Polio Plus during their recent campaign.

Contributions ranged from \$20 up to \$500. The RI Foundation agreed to match gifts of \$25 or more up to \$50, or \$1990. Considering that we started the campaign late to avoid conflicting with the State of the Town and the Mayor's Ball, the response was outstanding. Lew Million

Today there are only three countries that still have cases of polio: Afghanistan, Pakistan and Nigeria. Less than 370 polio cases were confirmed worldwide in 2014, which is a reduction of 99% since 1980, when the world saw around 1,000 cases a day according to the RI website.
