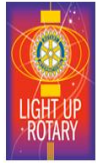

On **Friday, August 14th** the crew from Project Sanctuary will be at Sam's Club in Lone Tree at 9:15 a.m. and need help loading the groceries and supplies into their vehicle and then drive (car pool) to the YMCA Camp in Granby, CO to unload the groceries, unload the storage closet, unload the bus, and help set up the lodge for the retreat and get Orientation Packets together and make name tags). Then drive back home.

On **Saturday, August 15th** – you can drive to Granby, CO and see some of what the veterans and their families do on a retreat. The June 18th presentation was given by Sharon McCreary, UN Refuge Program for Colorado, English as a Second Language.



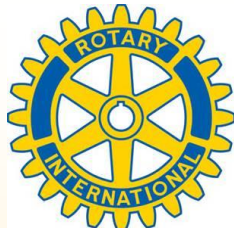

Polio Plus Update

The Rotary Club of Parker had 51 members give a total of \$3250 to Polio Plus during their recent campaign.

Contributions ranged from \$20 up to \$500. The RI Foundation agreed to match gifts of \$25 or more up to \$50, or \$1990. Considering that we started the campaign late to avoid conflicting with the State of the Town and the Mayor's Ball, the response was outstanding. Low Million

Today there are only three countries that still have cases of polio: Afghanistan, Pakistan and Nigeria. Less than 370 polio cases were confirmed worldwide in 2014, which is a reduction of 99% since 1980, when the world saw around 1,000 cases a day according to the RI website.
