Peter Scott inducted Brent DeRaad, President & CEO of Arlington Convention Center, into the club.

Sally Hopper presented both Chad Bates and Joy Bates with Paul Harris Fellowships +1.

Sally Hopper wished a happy birthday to Coy Garrett and Norman Douglas. We also celebrated Rotarians with anniversaries this week: Melody Fowler, Valerie Landry and Sal Capuli.

President-Elect Victoria Farrar-Myers presented today's program, Scott Nassar, Managing Director Live by Loews. Scott was previously with the Ritz Carlton for sixteen years and won two Malcolm Baldridge National Quality Awards. He has opened over 64 properties throughout his career including the original Live by Loews here in Arlington.

Live by Loews is a 14-floor, 300-room, \$150 million dollar luxury hotel that opened in Arlington's Entertainment District in 2020. 33% of the team members are from Arlington. It is owned 25% by the Texas Rangers, 25% by Cordish Companies and 50% by Loews Hotels & Co. With the ownership set up this way it allows these organizations to act as both owners and managers, allowing them to reinvest in the hotel. This year alone ownership is reinvesting \$550,000 into the hotel. Scott went on to mention that the hotel industry is recognizing that the economy is opening back up. In the last 21 days Live by Loews' occupancy has gone up 80%. In quarter one 5800 rooms were filled by corporate groups. In April corporate groups occupied 3000 rooms. In May this number is expected to grow to 4700 rooms.

The new Loews Arlington Hotel is expected to be 100' taller than Live by Loews with 888 rooms, 96 of those being suites, 44-break out rooms, 260,000

square feet of indoor meeting space and 30,000 square feet of outdoor space, including a massive video wall, space for food trucks, outdoor smokers and live bands. Arlington Loews will also include a 2,000-square-foot area for kids and both a spa and a salon. The hotel will also have two additional restaurants with a third coming in down the street as well as a third-party restaurant.

The goal for the continued growth is to create a walkable destination spot. This will allow Arlington to continue to pull in larger-scale events and retain the guests here in Arlington with the luxury rooms and spaces being provided. Loews Arlington Hotel is expected to open in quarter one of 2024.

In honor of the program President Kurt presented a book to Scott Nassar that the club will donate to Webb Elementary on his behalf.
