as a historian and the importance of digitizing Arlington's history in general. He set out to intentionally collect Arlington's black history archives. He discovered so much history, rooms full. He took a step back and realized. Mark talked about a place in Arlington called "The Hill".

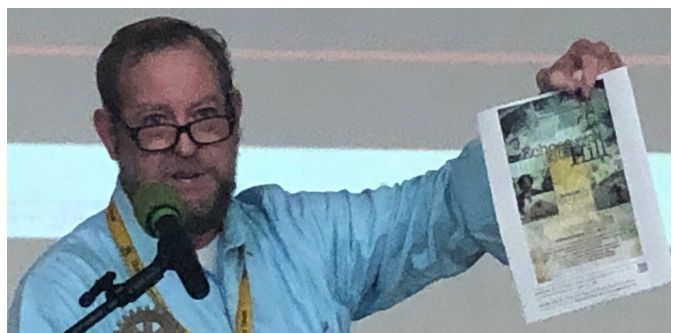
"The Hill" is a historic, five-block area of Arlington. It was the only area designated for the city's African American residents when racially segregated neighborhoods were the norm. Located northwest of the town's original boundaries, its area included Sanford, West, Prairie, and Taylor streets.

Mark is in the process of being a part of a documentary that is laying the groundwork for what will make to share Arlington's Black History. If you are interested in learning more about The Hill? Visit the Arlington Public Library's Black History Community Archive. This digital collection, created and hosted by the library, will provide free searchable access 24/7 to many of the historical photos, recordings, and documents that will be featured in the "Echoes from The Hill" documentary projects. 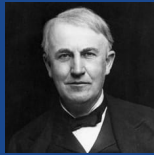
