Speaker: Dr. Jennifer Cowley, President, University of Texas at Arlington

Jennifer Cowley, an Arlington native, attended Arlington High School and worked at Six Flags. She remembers when the ballpark opened, it had a TGI Friday. So much has changed in the entertainment district since then. Cowley's first experience on the UTA Campus was as a 6th grader for an orchestra camp. It was a life-changing experience. UTA is important and impactful.

Cowley comes to Arlington from the University of North Texas, where she served as the provost and vice president of academic affairs since 2017. She was also a professor in the university's health and public services college. She's credited with doubling UNT's research expenditures, establishing a Frisco campus and improving representation among

women and underrepresented groups within UNT's faculty and administrators, according to a January UT System press release. She earned her doctorate in urban and regional science from Texas A&M University and master's degrees from Texas A&M and UNT.

Before serving at UNT, Cowley spent 16 years at The Ohio State University, where she served as the vice provost for capital planning and regional campuses, head of city and regional planning and associate engineering college dean.

Jennifer Cowley hopes to make UTA a more inclusive university impacting more students with a great college education. Part of the ways Cowley hopes to achieve that is by making career pathways that will lead high school students to UTA.




